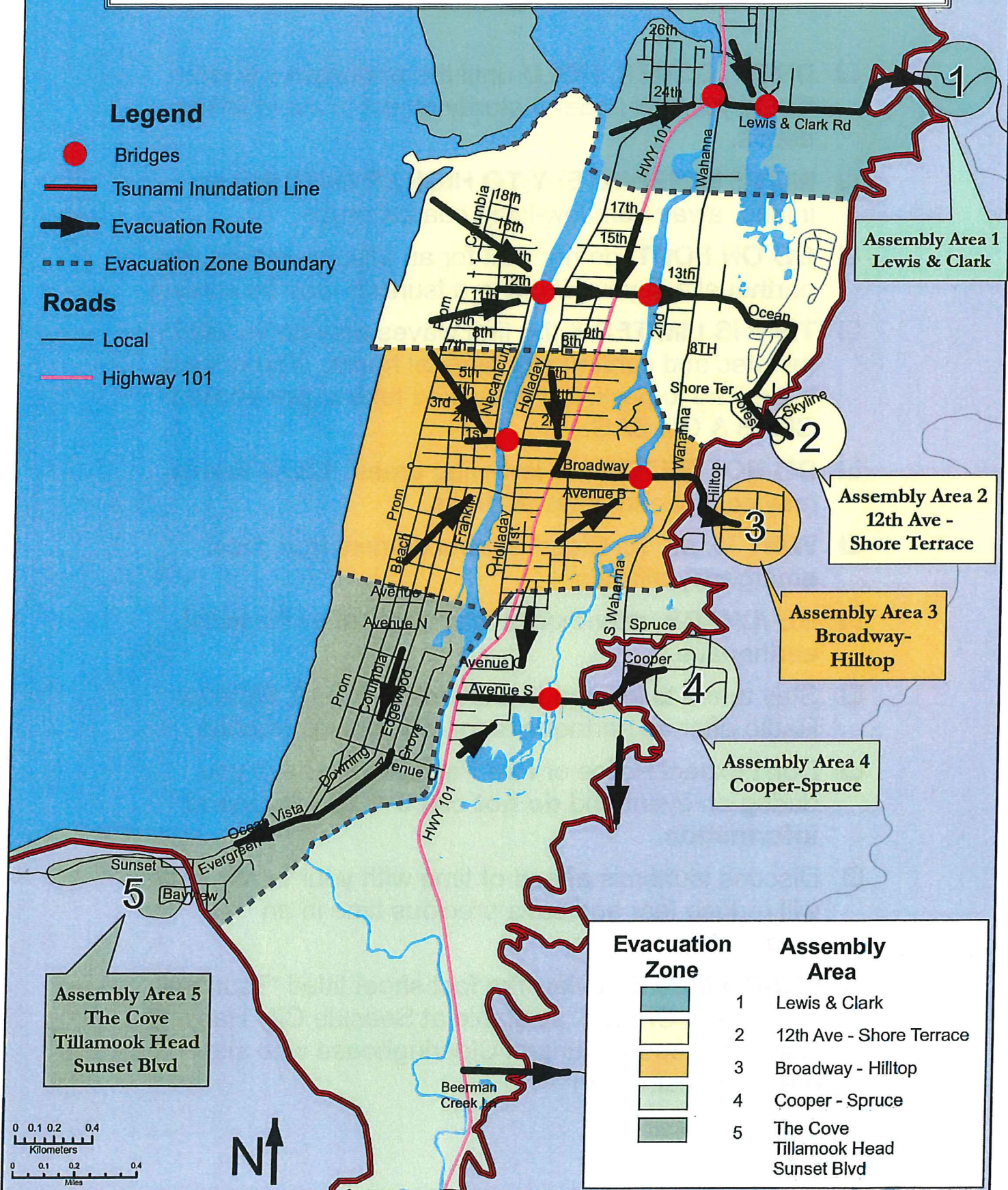
Tsunami Evacuation & Assembly

IF YOU FEEL THE EARTH SHAKE

- DROP, COVER, HOLD** until the earthquake is over. Brace yourself under a sturdy object to avoid falling debris.
- MOVE IMMEDIATELY TO HIGHER GROUND** or inland, away from low-lying coastal areas.
- GO ON FOOT**, do not wait for an official warning, the earthquake is your warning a tsunami may be coming.
- TIME IS LIMITED** & the first waves may arrive within minutes and continue for several hours. You will not have time to pack, but you could take a pre-packed **GRAB & GO BAG**..
- DO NOT RETURN** to low-lying areas. Large waves may continue for several hours.
- WAIT** for an "All Clear" announcement from local emergency officials.
- BE AWARE**, aftershocks may occur after the initial earthquake.
- Stay tuned to local radio stations or NOAA Weather Radio after an earthquake for tsunami information.
- Don't expect Police or Fire Personnel to save you during an event and **do not call 9-1-1 for tsunami information**.
- Discuss tsunamis ahead of time with your family. This will reduce fear and save precious time in an emergency.
