Reminder: Monthly Tsunami Warning System Testing in Seaside

The City of Seaside will test the Tsunami Warning System on Wednesday, May 7, 2014, beginning at 11:00 a.m. This test is conducted to monitor and assess the notification system and will not be used as a public information trial alert. The warning will begin with three beeps and consist of a voice message stating, "This is a test. This is a test of the emergency warning system. This is only a test." The message will be broadcast in English and Spanish.

This test will be conducted the first Wednesday of each month through May 2014.

POLICE DEPARTMENT

Oregon State Police, Clatsop County Sheriffs, and Seaside Police Team Up to End Mini Crime Spree:

On Tuesday afternoon, Oregon State Police spotted a vehicle reported stolen from Seaside in connection with a residential burglary on 6th Avenue near the Prom. The two females in the vehicle claimed they were unaware the vehicle was stolen and soon lead officers from all three agencies to another address on 900 block of McCormick Gardens. While searching the residence, they located a trailer on the property that was locked. While waiting for the owner with a key, a male identified as Nathan Cutfinger age 27 of Warrenton was observed in the trailer, surrendered, and taken into custody for his involvement in the burglary and stolen vehicle. Cutfinger had been on the run since April 17, 2014, when he was identified as the person responsible for a burglary and theft at the Shilo Inn. Hotel surveillance allowed officers to identify him and they learned he also had 2 felony warrants and two misdemeanor warrants that included Assault 4, FTA on Theft, and two Probation Violation Warrants all out of Clatsop County. Officers spotted him in the area of 6th & Roosevelt on Saturday afternoon but he ran and after searching the area using a Clatsop County K-9, they were unable to locate him. Cutfinger was transported to the Clatsop County Jail charged with 1st Degree Burglary, 2nd Degree Burglary, Theft I, Theft III, Unlawful Use of a Motor Vehicle, Criminal Mischief III, Escape III, and the Warrants. Seaside Police want to thank all the troopers and deputies who assisted these investigations to a successful conclusion.




The City of Seaside and Seaside Police Department use Nixle alerts* to inform the community when it is necessary to get information out in a timely fashion. Nixle alerts come in the form of an SMS text message, email, or both (depending on your free subscription).



Examples of alerts include the announcement of a Tsunami warning system test, high water levels or an accident along Highway 101 that may impact travel.
