### Reminder: Monthly Tsunami Warning System Testing in Seaside

The City of Seaside will test the Tsunami Warning System on Wednesday, May 7, 2014, beginning at 11:00 a.m. This test is conducted to monitor and assess the notification system and will not be used as a public information trial alert. The warning will begin with three beeps and consist of a voice message stating, "This is a test. This is a test of the emergency warning system. This is only a test." The message will be broadcast in English and Spanish.

This test will be conducted the first Wednesday of each month through May 2014.

## PUBLIC WORKS

**WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT:**  
It's time to fire up the dryer! After a long project and a fair amount of waiting, the first test runs of the dryer system took place this Thursday. We have had the technician from Fenton Environmental Industries here since last Saturday working out the bugs on our machine (It's been several years since it has been run) and testing all of the various components. This is also the first time we have used the belt press since moving it inside. I'm pleased to announce that everything seems to be working and we hope to be starting our pilot project to be certified Class A with DEQ next week.



### AVENUE 'U' BRIDGE

The City received the 30% design from the engineers at OBEC. Unfortunately there are difficult geotechnical conditions at the bridge site in the form of large round rock. Finding round rock in the area was no surprise but we were somewhat surprised to learn how deep the layer was. The drill crew was down over 40 feet and was still in the difficult rock layer. This means that we will not be able to drive pilings but will have to use drill shafts.

This adds close to half a million dollars to the cost of the project. Staff and the engineers are looking to find cost saving measures that will make it possible for us to move forward with this project. We will be presenting our findings to the Improvement Commission and the City Council at their May meetings.




**If not, you should be and it's easy to subscribe.**

The City of Seaside and Seaside Police Department use Nixle alerts\* to inform the community when it is necessary to get information out in a timely fashion. Nixle alerts come in the form of an SMS text message, email, or both (depending on your free subscription).



Examples of alerts include the announcement of a Tsunami warning system test, high water levels or an accident along Highway 101 that may impact travel.




