CONVENTION CENTER

Hello from the Convention Center!

The convention center was host to the Oregon Chapter of the American Public Works Association (APWA) March 29-31, 2016. The APWA put on its spring Street Maintenance and Collection Systems School. The group's general session focused on the recent OPB special video documentary "Unprepared" and included a discussion on how to pursue resilient public works infrastructure. Topics for the break-out sessions included hydro excavating, Cured in Place Pipe (CIPP), Bypass Pumping, Traffic Incident Management, OSHA Accident Investigation, Low-Cost Safety Improvements, and other topics relevant to street maintenance and collection systems.

The convention center is scheduled to host the Oregon Ghost Conference, put on by Northwest Walking Tours, begins Friday, April 1, 2016 to Sunday, April 3, 2016. The conference features guest speakers from throughout the Pacific Northwest and western United States. There will be multiple classes, nighttime ghost tours and investigations, meet-and-greet events, after-parties, vendors and ghost stories over bonfires. 


LIBRARY
