
VISITORS BUREAU

CONVENTION CENTER

Hello from the Convention Center! The Association of Christian Schools International held its annual conference from Sunday, April 24, 2016, to Tuesday, April 26, 2016. The association's 2016 Seaside Leadership Conference included several keynote speakers and seminars on improving student learning, recruiting, and retaining students, standardized testing and more.

On Thursday, April 28, 2014, the convention center hosted the North Coast Opioid Summit: Moving Communities to Action. The event was sponsored by the Columbia Pacific CCO and the Oregon Coalition for Responsible Use of Meds.

Physicians, physician assistants, nurses, dentists, pharmacists, psychiatrists and other health care and treatment providers, educators, law enforcement personnel, public health providers and representatives from prevention organizations attended the summit. The purpose was to develop a Regional Action Plan to move discussion into action and create momentum for statewide change on prescription drug misuse and abuse. The conference brought in a higher than expected turnout.

Lastly, the convention center will host the Oregon Scholastic Chess Federation on Friday, April 29, 2016, and Saturday, April 30, 2016, for the 11th annual OSCF State Championship.

Qualifying students of all ages from across Oregon are coming to participate in the chess competition, which includes some fun blitz and bughouse games before the age and rating-based section and championship games the following day.





Broadway to close at 5 a.m. Saturday for street cleaning and 5K Race

Seaside, Ore. – April 29, 2016 – The City of Seaside will close Broadway between Highway 101 (Roosevelt) and the Turnaround beginning at 5 a.m. on Saturday, April 30. The city's Public Works department will utilize these early morning hours to clean and pressure wash the downtown core before giving way to the already planned shutdown of Broadway for the Seaside Dash to Safety 5K Run/Walk and 2K Doggy Dash. The 5K race begins at 9:30 a.m. at the Seaside Cove with runners navigating north along the Promenade to the Turnaround before heading east on Broadway.

"It's difficult to find the perfect time to take care of some of these maintenance tasks we have," said Public Works Director Dale McDowell. "With the race already scheduled to take place, we decided this would be a good way to get some extra work in prior to the start of the race."

After passing through the intersection of Broadway and Roosevelt, runners will run east to Wahanna, where they will then turn right, jogging south to Spruce Drive before crossing the finish line at Seaside Heights Elementary School. A second race, the shorter 2K Doggy Dash, will begin at Broadway Park, also at 9:30 a.m. The annual Seaside Safety Fair will run from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. following the conclusion of both races. Broadway will completely reopen again at 10 a.m.

"The combination of events is something we've been working on for several months now," stated Jon Rahl, spokesman for the City of Seaside. "The whole idea behind the day is emergency preparedness and taking stock of what individually we can do to keep ourselves safe." Events are taking place nationwide in honor of National Preparedness Day.

Residents should also be advised that the City of Seaside will be using the Tsunami Warning System to start the races at 9:30 a.m. This is the non-siren system and only speakers at the Cove and Sunset Hills will be utilized. Those interested in still participating in the race can register at Seaside Heights beginning at 8 a.m. The four-hour safety fair is free to the public.




