Reminder: Monthly Tsunami Warning System Testing in Seaside

The City of Seaside will test the Tsunami Warning System on Wednesday, May 6, 2015, beginning at 11:00 a.m. This test is conducted to monitor and assess the notification system and will not be used as a public information trial alert. The warning will begin with three beeps and consist of a voice message stating, "This is a test. This is a test of the emergency warning system. This is only a test." The message will be broadcast in English and Spanish.

This test will be conducted the first Wednesday of each month through May 2015.






What does 5-2-1-0 stand for?






