Some of the new popular fiction titles we just received are: "Friction" by Sandra Brown in which Texas Ranger Crawford Hunt saves a judge from a masked assassin, but his act of heroism may jeopardize the most important thing in his life. "The Fifth Heart" by Dan Simmons brings together Sherlock Holmes and Henry James for a romp through America in 1893, as they try to solve a mysterious death in one of the country's most noted families. If popular fiction is not your coupe, tasse (cup of tea) then here are some titles that may appeal when you are having intellectual yearnings: "Neuro Tribes", by Steve Silberman, is a sweeping and penetrating account that takes a detailed and dense history of autism and turns the story into a genuine page-turner. "The Witches", by Stacy Schiff, is the story of the Salem witch trials of 1692 and is a riveting description of a seminal episode in our country that unveils a primal American mystery. If you're hungry for something in between these two genres then belly up to the table with "Nom Nom Paleo: Food for Humans" by Michelle Tam, who brings you over 100 recipes for eating healthy that actually tastes good. These are just a few of the new titles that may pique your interest.


