
POLICE DEPARTMENT



Seaside Police Department honored fallen officers by wearing special memorial badges on May 15.

The Seaside Police Department is recognizing National Police Week by wearing special memorial badges on May 15, in recognition of the annual National Peace Officers Memorial Day. In 1962, President John F. Kennedy signed a proclamation designating May 15 as Peace Officers Memorial Day and the week in which that date falls as Police Week. Currently, tens of thousands of law enforcement officers from around the world converge in Washington DC, to participate in a number of planned events that honor those who have paid the ultimate sacrifice. A total of 1,466 law enforcement officers died in the line of duty during the past 10 years, an average of one death every 60 hours or 146 per year.

117 law enforcement officers were killed in the line of duty in 2014, while there have already been 40 law enforcement officers killed in 2015 while on duty as of May 7, 2015. The Seaside Police Department invited citizens to learn more about the heroes of American law enforcement and join us in respecting, honoring, and remembering them. 
