Reminder: Monthly Tsunami Warning System Testing in Seaside

The City of Seaside will test the Tsunami Warning System on Wednesday, October 7, 2015, beginning at 11:00 a.m. This test is conducted to monitor and assess the notification system and will not be used as a public information trial alert. The warning will begin with three beeps and consist of a voice message stating, "This is a test. This is a test of the emergency warning system. This is only a test." The message will be broadcast in English and Spanish.

This test will be conducted the first Wednesday of each month through May 2015.

This week the convention center is hosting the ACBL Regional Bridge Tournament from September 28, 2015 to October 4, 2015, with 700 attendees.





COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT




